Professional Development

1. The committee shall have at least one meeting per year.
2. The Professional Development committee is charged with approving the quality, content and presenters of any USOF AZ sanctioned seminar or event for compliance with the USOF AZ continuing education requirements.
3. Meet, discuss, explore and compile suggestions and ideas to be recommended to the Board of Directions for implementation.

Meet, discuss, explore and compile suggestions and ideas. The Professional Development Committee works in unison with the Continuing education Committee and is charged with establishing guidelines for scheduling, pricing and profit division of USOF AZ sanctioned seminars and educational events.

Government Affairs

1. When the Arizona General Assembly is in session, the Government Affairs Committee will obtain and review a synopsis of all proposed Senate and House Bills for possible affect to the Arizona Land Surveying profession.
2. Bills which are determined to have an effect will be reviewed and evaluated and either supported or opposed with the appropriate legislators being notified of USOF AZ's concerns and/or desires.

The Government Affairs Committee would contact or approach Associations or Boards for possible liaison, exchange of information, interaction or feedback, and pursue and promote interest of the Land Surveying Profession. Contact, work with, and provide assistance to deal with concerns of, and pursue and promote interest of the Land Surveying Profession.

The Government Affairs Committee will review and comment on existing laws and administrative rules that affect Arizona Professional Land Surveying.

Ethics and Practice:

In all matters brought before this Committee, the primary objective shall be the protection of the quality of land surveying in Arizona. The Committee shall, in the pursuit of the objective, always bear in mind the public interest, the professional interest, and the rights of the individual surveyor and general public.

By-Laws

Review all written proposed amendments or additions to the By-Laws. The committee shall submit the reviewed proposals for amendments and additions to the Official Board of Directions for rejection or approval.

Budget & Finance

1. Meet as needed to set a budget for each fiscal year.

2. Meet through the year to monitor the budget and make any recommendations to the Board of Directions.
3. Investigate ways of funding the Association and make recommendations to the Board of Directions.

Publications and Social Media

1. The Publications and Social Media Committee shall cooperate with the Association Director in the publication and maintenance of the following:
 - A. The USOF AZ Newsletter
 - B. The UsOF AZ Facebook page
 - C. The USOF AZ Instagram account
 - D. The USOF AZ web page
2. The Publications AND Social Media Committee shall develop and/or assist in publishing other material:
 - A. As requested by the Board of Directions
 - B. As requested by the public
 - C. As requested by the Committee members

Meet, discuss, explore and compile suggestions and ideas. The Continuing Education Committee is works in unison with the Professional Development Committee and is charged with establishing and enforcing guidelines for the USOF AZ Continuing Education program.
